The following contains New Information sent to us from Transportation starting in January...

Information on Temporary Bus Passes for Students

Elementary and High School:

When a parent needs their student to ride the bus home with another student, they must call the Transportation Department 24 hours in advance. Please call 651-425-5303. Transportation will review rider loads and confirm or deny a Bus Pass based on availability. All confirmed Bus Passes will be issued in a standard format and sent from Transportation to the School. The student should pick up the Bus Pass from the school office and present it to the Bus Driver.

Other:

- Bus Passes are not intended to be used for social reasons (i.e. play dates, birthday parties, etc.). They should be used for emergency situations only.
- All Bus Passes are temporary one day passes.
- All Bus Pass requests must be made 24 hours in advance (special consideration may be made for emergency situations).
- Students must also be issued a Bus Pass if they need to get on/off at an alternate stop** on their already assigned route. Again, this should be for emergency situations only.
- Correspondence from parents/guardians (i.e. hand written notes, text message shown to Drivers, etc.) **will NOT be accepted by Drivers** as a valid Bus Pass.

Winter Weather:

Please ensure that your child is dressed appropriately for the winter weather.

We make every effort for routes to be on time throughout the year. With winter weather here, the possibility for delay increases greatly. Buses running more than 10 minutes late will be posted on the District Website on the main Transportation page, right side. If you have questions about your child's route, please call 651-425-5303.

Special Education Bus Attendance:

Please call 651-425-5303 if your student will be absent from Special Education transportation. Please press 1 on the main menu for Special Education Routing.

Your child has been building memories all year long – the yearbook is a great way to capture those memories! Your child will bring home a flyer on Friday January 12th with all of the details, but here are some frequently asked questions:

How do I buy a yearbook?

All purchases must be done online. Go to <https://ybpay.lifetouch.com/> and use code **1470418** for Middleton. You can also search by state and city to select Middleton. Follow the steps on the screen. After your order is submitted you will receive a confirmation email containing the specifics of your order.

When is my order due?

The deadline for purchasing yearbooks is March 15, 2018.

I can't remember if I ordered a yearbook yet this year?

Go to <https://ybpay.lifetouch.com/> and click on "Get details of your previous orders by email". It will let you know if you have placed an order for 2017-2018. The yearbook team can also check current orders for you, just inquire at Middletonyearbooks@gmail.com

When will my child receive his/her yearbook?

Yearbooks are delivered to the classrooms the last week of school.

How do I order multiple yearbooks if I have more than one child who attends Middleton?

You can order yearbooks for multiple Middleton students at once:

- Go to <https://ybpay.lifetouch.com/>
- Enter 1470418 for Middleton
- Enter one child's name and grade, click next
- Select that child's yearbook options, click next
- On the billing page, you will see an order summary on the right. Below that is a link that says "Place additional order for this school" – click on that.
- You will be returned to the page where you enter your child's name and grade. Enter the second child's information, click next.
- Repeat these steps until you have ordered yearbooks for each child, then enter your billing information and finish the process.

I have some good photos I'd like to see included in the yearbook. What should I do with them?

We would love to include your pictures of any school event, whether a restaurant night, field trip, PTO event, classroom activity, etc! Teachers do a great job providing our team with photos taken throughout the year, but we need yours too! We've added a few extra pages to the yearbook so we can include as many candid shots as possible – we know the kids love to see themselves in multiple places in the yearbook! - Adults-Only Parties: 8 people willing to host, 60% of people interested in attending
